NURTURING LOCAL YOUTH IN SOCCER

San Francisco Vikings take pride in its player development programs, offering local youth the chance to grow and thrive in the beautiful game in Northern California.

YOUTH SOCCER PROGRAMS

Microsoccer: (PreK to 1st Grade):

Introductory games teaching basic soccer fundamentals and teamwork for young children. Ignite their love for the game in a well-run microsoccer league.

Youth Recreational: (2nd to 8th Grade):

Enjoy the game with friends, learn basics, and build lifelong friendships. Form school teams, play with friends, or join as an individual in a nurturing recreational environment.

Competitive Local: (Ages 8 to 12 years):

Step up from recreational play in the San Francisco competitive league. Focus on technical skills development for players serious about advancing their game.

Competitive Travel: (Ages 8 to 18 years):

For advanced players seeking top-level training and play in Northern California's advanced leagues. Requires tryouts and a 1-year player commitment for dedicated "soccer first" players and families.

Recreational and Micro: Red Jersey (\$46.99), Team Shorts (\$24.29), Team Socks (\$9.89) = \$81.17

Competitive: Above, plus White Jersey (\$46.99), Practice Jersey (\$21.04), Sweatshirt (\$58.49) = \$207.69

Summer Camp: (Ages 4 to 12 years):

Duration: 6 weeks (starts in July)

Cost:

- Full Days: \$485
- Half Days: \$270

Before and After Care available for an extra fee.

KEY PLAYER POLICIES

Game Time Policy:

Game time depends on consistent attendance, punctuality, effort, and a positive attitude. Both Recreational and Competitive teams ensure a 40% guaranteed game time. Any reductions are communicated in advance by the coach and approved by the Director of Coaching for transparency and fairness.

Guest Playing Opportunities:

Players can guest play for other Vikings teams facing scheduling challenges without incurring extra fees. This provides an opportunity to explore more competitive play without committing to a full season upfront.

Travel Team Residency Requirement:

Teams below high school level allow up to 2 non-resident players, and high school teams permit up to 3. This policy prioritizes San Francisco residents' access to field space. Parents of travel team players are requested to submit proof of residency to comply with this requirement.
