 - This helps continue building a connected player pool across the club
 - Creates a more unified and supportive environment between teams and age groups
- **Local Showcase Events (U15+)**
 - Strategic local showcase opportunities for older age groups
 - Additional exposure and competitive matches
- **Grand Park Event (U13-U14)**
 - Strong regional competition
 - Opportunity for younger teams to compete against quality opposition from outside the area

League Placement if Not Accepted Into N1

- If a Rouge team is not accepted into N1, the plan would be to compete in the highest level of MSPSP appropriate for that team
- We believe the level of competition and developmental environment will still allow players to continue progressing at a high level while maintaining a strong player pool and competitive training environment across the club

Additional Player Pathway Opportunities

- Potential roster spots may include an ECNL RL Player Pool position
- Players within the RL Player Pool will receive:
 - One guaranteed training session per week with the ECNL RL team
 - Ongoing evaluation within the ECNL RL environment
 - Potential opportunities to participate in ECNL RL matches when needed

The Competitive Plan **PRE-ECNL & DA**

Our **PRE-ECNL** and **Director's Academy** teams (U11-U12) will follow a similar developmental pathway. While event schedules are still being finalized, this structure will help strengthen the overall player pool, provide additional opportunities for "bubble players," and better prepare players for the transition into the 11v11 game. Resume Workshops

In these workshops players will learn to navigate the system, update their profiles, learn how to search for schools based on many facets and most importantly; the do's and don't's of contacting potential coaches.



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MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

PURPOSE

To enrich both mentor and mentees experience through the following:

- Two way mentoring that requires active participation from both parties
- Setting clear goals for each session through preparedness and being open to feedback
- Using active listening as a tool to enhance and foster mentoring relationships
- Respecting time by setting meetings that start and end on time

While this is an intentional pairing of youth soccer players, we have seen it build a relationship beyond mentoring.

- For all U7-U10 teams matched with U13-U16 teams
- First meet up at Team Camp
- Once a month mentor training
- One (1) game per season sideline support; fall, winter* and spring
(*winter is schedule dependent)

Each year going forward the new class of U7 and U13 will join in until all age groups are included.

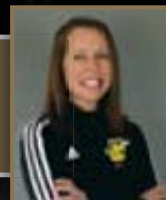
Team pairings/groups will continue until U19 and U12 where the next year the U12 mentees become the mentors.

DO YOU NEED ITC?

The international clearance (ITC) process is required for ALL players, for ALL clubs, in ALL states from ALL countries if the player was born outside of the United States (including U.S. citizens born abroad) or if the player previously registered to play soccer with a club/team/league outside of the United States.



There are many clearance pathways and each one is unique. If you fall into one of these scenarios above and have not been cleared by US Soccer, please contact Jamie Scott as soon as possible as the process requires different documentation. Please note that the process can take weeks and months as it must go through the state to US Soccer and then onto FIFA before landing in the soccer association for the country in question (and then back). So please don't delay, the sooner we get this documentation submitted, the better.
